The registration fee for this training is only \$35. **Everyone must pay the registration fee.** Scholarships are available to pay the cost of double occupancy lodging. SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

If you intend to apply for a scholarship, read the paragraph below and sign if you agree with these terms.

"I certify that I am not a federal employee and I am a victim or I work with victims of violent crimes or potential federal crimes such as gun offenses and Violence Against Women Act Offenses. I understand that I must attend the entire conference from 1:00 pm August 9, 2011 through noon August 11, 2011 to be eligible for the scholarship money. Further, I understand that I will personally be held financially liable for the cost of the room if I do not attend and fail to cancel my conference registration by the August 1, 2011 deadline. I have also attempted to obtain funding from my agency prior to submitting the application. Signing below indicates my agreement with the information above concerning lodging scholarships.

The scholarship will pay for two nights double occupancy only. Due to governmental regulations, scholarship recipients will be reimbursed for the cost of lodging. The lodging will be billed to your credit card or you may pay cash. No scholarship funds are available for mileage, additional meals, or other expenses.

Note: Each room will require a credit card upon registration at the hotel to cover non-lodging charges that may occur. As normal operating procedures, hotels typically place a hold on funds in the credit card account to cover charges. If you use a debit card at check-in, a hold will be placed on some of your funds.
